Strengthening Services



To support the development of a new strategic plan, the MCP Team engaged in a half-day retreat reviewing operations and brainstorming ideas for improving efficiency and strengthening client and mediator support. Recommendations for the integration of more technology and future workshops and educational opportunities were agreed upon as next steps. Working Together to Strengthen Hawaii's Communities

MCP was pleased to work with Hawaii Appleseed Center of Law & Economic Justice (Hawaii Appleseed) on their evaluation of the eviction mediation



program created in response to Act 57 and managed by MCP on Oahu over the past year. In the report

"Holding mediation prior to litigation rather than during is likely to help mediation participants avoid an eviction filing and from developing entrenched positions, which can reduce the pressure on tenants to accept settlements that require them to move out, increasing the likelihood of tenants remaining in place."

published by Hawaii Appleseed, Eviction
Prevention Through Hawaii's Tenant-Landlord
Mediation Program, they found that the Program
successfully assisted over 1,200 tenants and
landlords to avoid eviction.

Based on their findings, they recommend that prefiling eviction mediations be continued, paired with rental relief, to allow for further study of its efficacy.


